When we are filled with the love of God, we give generously to praise, serve, and witness as a disciple of Jesus Christ. On the second weekend of November, we will launch our pledge drive for the year 2024. Your Finance and Stewardship Committee created a budget document to share with you which puts a narrative to the missions and ministry of Sycamore United Methodist Church and an estimate of their cost. We come to you with a plan by lay members and staff who want to join with you in serving God. We are asking you to make a pledge so we know financially what we can do. Please prayerfully consider how you can use the gifts of time, talent, and treasures entrusted to you by God to be a purposeful witness for Jesus Christ.

As we close our financial calendar year, we continue to need your extra help to meet a budget shortfall. We calculated that if each supporter gave an additional \$150 for each of the last three months of the year, our deficit would be met. Although numbers were still being counted at the time this newsletter went to press, we know we are making headway. Remember, there will be those unable to make any extra gift, so giving more than the \$150 a month will help make up the difference.


