LET THE HARVEST BEGIN

Fall harvest is underway and with it the hope of a bountiful return from spring plantings. God calls us to bring our first yield from the harvest to him as an offering. In Leviticus 23:10 we read, "When you come into the land which I give you and reap its harvest, then you shall bring a sheaf of the first fruits of your harvest to the priest." You don't have to be a farmer to get the idea of "first fruits" being relevant. The scripture is saying whatever form your income takes, you freely give first in worshipful thanks to God for all he has done for you. You are giving as a celebration to God, with no guilt or obligation.



Author Jesse Wisnewski in his article "Guide to Understand First Fruits Offerings," says making a first fruit offering opens us up to allow God to work in our life. He points out that when we approach God with open hands – rather than clenched fists- we show God we are obedient to him and he can trust us to be his active disciples here on earth.
