While there our team painted the church, did tile work, poured concrete pads, assembled concrete tables and benches, and a team leading VBS. Deno was able to do many things around the church that have been being put off for years because they didn't have anyone. Our team was also taking time for their spiritual journey as every morning they did their devotions and then in the evening our team would gather to deeper into conversation around the Word. After all that hard work they also took time for some fun on our adventure day (DENO DAY WE CALLED IT) as we went to an area where they saw many dinosaurs (even moving ones with sound) walked to a waterfall and also took time too swim in some water areas where the river was coming from the volcano area which caused it to be neon blue.

Once I returned home at 3am on Saturday I quickly changed gears and our LIFE Missions Junior team started their mission time. Becca and I were blessed to have 25 youth join us for a few days, and boy were they busy. Becca took a team out to do yard work at one of our members house while I stayed at the church with the older youth in the group to paint the lower half of the gym. "REFUGEE GOOD NEIGHBOR TEAM" NEWS

We want to thank Helen Maurer for all her hard work as our team leader, she will be stepping back from those duties, so she can devote time to the most important role of being a grandma for the first time. Our team will miss her dedication and organizational skills that have kept our mission to help our refugee families on track. Leader duties are being split up amongst our team.

Our work continues with our 2 families from Afghanistan. We are currently helping one family with the process of becoming lawful permanent residents of the U.S., aka Green Card.

World Relief offers legal services for this process and a \$500 donation from SUMC has helped pay the small fee for this. The other family used their \$500 SUMC donation to help pay for dental work. Both families continue to need our assistance with rides to appointments and shopping.

Happy news, one of our families, Masoud and his wife Qalima, are expecting a baby in December, several trips for OB appointments have been made. The baby girl will be joining her 4 year old and 3 year old sisters, much fun is expected in their household!

Both families currently have some personal challenges that we ask for your prayers, adjusting to a new way of life is difficult and we thank our church members for their continued support and prayers.
