We continue to have adventures grocery shopping, going to the laundromat, transporting to doctor appointments, playing with the children, and hearing their stories. We are witnessing their English language improving which helps our relationships.

World Relief is hosting a "Summer Club" for refugee children July 18 - 22 at the Advent Christian Church at 905 N. Edgelawn Dr. In Aurora which is 35 minutes from here. The time is 10:00 - 2:00. Marlina, our World Relief Volunteer Coordinator is wondering if some from our church would be willing to be leaders for the children. With 6 - 7 volunteers, Marlina would come to SUMC for a mini orientation and there would be an expedited screening for volunteers. STEWARDSHIP IN ACTIONCan Our Church Conquer Inflation?

(Adapted from text by Rev. Ken Sloane, Director of Stewardship and Generosity, United Methodist Church)

It seems that it has been quite a few years since inflation has been on our minds and on our radar, though we know this is changing right now. If your contribution was able to be level through the past two years of the pandemic, you are doing better than most church experts expected. Praise God and thank you for those efforts – adapting and innovating! However, even in this short time, we know it would take a 13 percent increase in contributions just to match the inflation-adjusted dollars of 2019! That means that a pledge of \$400 a month in 2019 would need to be \$452 a month in 2022.

If we are going to accomplish our mission of making "disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world," we need to be aware of the funding realities that are present. If we are content with a goal of "keeping things level from year to year," we need to understand that our church will really provide less mission and ministry impact. Is that what we want?

The reality is that many people are facing the same inflation challenge as the church. But for some of you, your circumstances are more flexible. As the Apostle Paul wrote: "You will be made rich in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God" (2 Corinthians 9:11). Can we count on your extra support?
