STEWARDSHIP IN ACTION THINKING ABOUT THREE GIFTS

The story about Wise Men from the East following a star that leads them to baby Jesus is found in the book of Matthew and includes this passage, "...and going into the house they saw the child with Mary his mother, and they fell down and worshiped him. Then opening their treasures, they offered him gifts, gold and frankincense and myrrh." (Matthew 2:11) The Wise Men impart a timeless lesson on generosity through their actions. Each gift holds symbolic and valuable significance. Gold in the context of this story is a way to acknowledge Jesus' divinity – God in the flesh; frankincense is a gum from a tree and was burned in worship services as part of offerings of thanks to God; and myrrh is a spice used in embalming and predicts Jesus giving His life on the cross for those who believe in him.



Today we are called to give three gifts of our own, those of:

Time – Such as attendance at worship, being part of a bible study, or supporting a church committee.

Talents - Think of singing in the choir, playing handbells, or teaching Sunday School.

Treasures – Giving regular offerings, supporting food for the needy and shelter for the homeless or homebound, or making provisions for legacy giving in your memory.

In this new year please prayerfully consider how you can approach generosity with the same spirit as the three Wise Men. 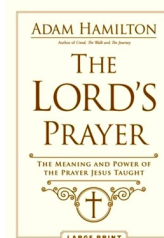
OPPORTUNITIES TO GATHER, GROW, AND SERVE

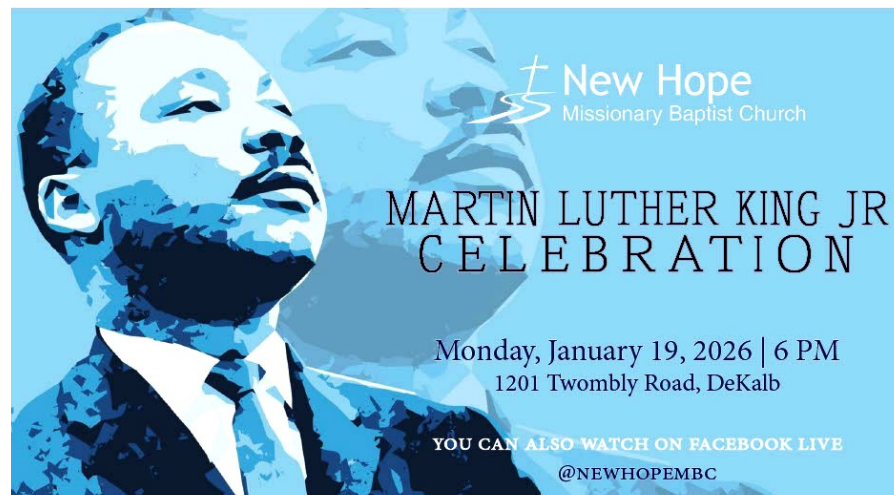
Children's Choir meets Wednesday's at 5:30-6:00 pm . Currently we have two children's choirs. Jr Choir and Kids Choir.
