Cell phones are now commonplace in most people's daily lives, and frequently we are told to "silence" our phones before the start of worship. But what might happen if we could call God during worship to ask him how he saw our effort in fulfilling the purpose for which he created us? What kind of marks would he give us for being his witness, or how we were doing in our service to others, or how we are doing in our giving? Would God tell us that he is pleased with the ways we are using the time, talents, and treasures he has entrusted to us?



Think about your attendance at worship and participation as a member of the choir, an usher, communion assistant, coffee host, or church van driver. How do you help support Sunday school, our local youth Life Missions program or the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR)? Are you part of an adult video, book, or Bible study group? Do you help with the Food Pantry, help with meals at Hope Haven, or deliver Meals on Wheels to shut ins? Are you part of United Women in Faith, United Methodist Men, or serve on the Church Council?

In 2 Corinthians 8:7 the Apostle Paul writes to the church in Corinth, "But just as you excel in everything – in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in complete earnestness and in your love for us...see that you also excel in this grace of giving." Through your generosity, God makes an impact on the lives of those around us. The missions and ministries of Sycamore United Methodist Church are only made possible through your generous support.





BACK TO BASICS: 25-26 MINISTRY THEME


Jesus reminds us to lean into the simple things. He spent years studying and praying, the basics of God's will, before going out into the world to build relationships and disciple others.

NEW MEMBER INFORMATION



All ages are welcome at all PRIDE events—we'd love to see you there!




WORSHIP, MUSIC AND ARTS
